SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS: PART ONE

1. JURISDICTION

This event is a **National Rally**, promoted by the **Hawkes Bay Car Club** and will take place on the **20th and 21st August in the Central Hawkes Bay and Hastings area.**

The **Tomoana Warehousing Rally Hawkes Bay Rally** is round five of the **2011 New Zealand Rally Championship**, round three of the **Geartech Central Region Rally Series** and incorporates the **Hugh Baird Memorial Rally.**

The Rally will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Three, Schedule R being the Standing Regulations for all Rallies and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

3. THE EVENT

For the avoidance of doubt the event will incorporate a number of separate competitions. Rally HB will be decided over Saturday and Sunday. The days will consist of

Clubmans – first leg of Rally HB

Sunday

NZRC – Round 5, Leg 2

Central Region Rally Series – Round 3

Clubmans – second leg of Rally HB

Hugh Baird Memorial Rally

3.1 Venue: The event is based in Napier with stages in Central Hawkes Bay and Hastings districts.

3.2 Length:

Saturday - Comprises of **87km** of special stages and **408 km** of touring.

Sunday - Comprises of **150km** of special stages and **354 km** of touring.

A full stage description is appended to these regulations (appendix A).

3.3 First Car Starts:

Saturday - From **Napier** at **7.00am**

Sunday - From **Napier** at **7.00am**

3.4 First Car Finishes:

Saturday - At **4.50 pm**, at the **end of day** control, which is situated at **Napier City**

Sunday - At **5.14 pm**, at the final control which is situated at **Napier City**

3.5 Central Region Rally Series will be contested on Day Two only.

3.6 Hugh Baird Memorial will be contested on Day Two only.

4. ENTRIES

4.1 Opening and Closing: These open with the publication of these regulations and close at **1700hrs** on **Monday 8th August 2011**

Entries post marked after the normal closing date will be subject to the late entry fee.

For the purposes of seeding, anyone wishing to enter after the 5th August should either fax their entry to 06 8794932 or email it to nic_lucke@xtra.co.nz, as well as posting their entry

Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the organiser.

4.2 Entry Acceptance: Entries shall be made on the correct form and to be deemed valid must be complete in all details and accompanied by the appropriate fees. Acceptance will be at the organising committee's discretion. Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

4.3 Fees:

A Withdrawal fee will be charged for competitors withdrawing after the closing date for normal entries. This fee will be

After the start of Reconnaissance there will be no refund of Entry Fee



4.4 Competing on Day Two

Competitors who have entered Day One Saturday can, prior to 1800hrs on Saturday the 20th August, register to compete on the second day by notifying Rally Headquarters. Competitors who fail to notify Headquarters prior to 1800hrs will be ineligible to compete on the second day. The fee to register for the second day in these circumstances will be \$ 3256.00 including GST.

4.5 Number of Starters:

The organisers reserve the right to abandon the event if less than 50 entries are received at normal closing date. The maximum number of starters will be 90. Any additional entries received will be placed on the reserve list in order of receipt.

4.6 Acceptance of Entry:

These will be notified by the 12th August together with the seeded start list.

4.7 Competitor Requirements:

(1) Knowledge and Understandings: In signing the entry forms competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules.

Particularly,

- (a) The National Sporting Code articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations, and
- (b) Appendix Three Schedule R articles pertaining to Stage notes, Pace notes and Reconnaissance.

(2) Licence Requirements: Both the No. 1 and No. 2 drivers shall hold a National Rally Grade or higher MotorSport NZ issued Competition Licence.

If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

(3) New Competitors: Any driver(s) who have not previously competed in three or more rallies must attend the new competitor special briefing. Details of venue and time will be announced with the acceptance of entry.

5. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

5.1 Compliance: All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Two Schedule A and Appendix Three Schedule R of the current MotorSport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.

5.2 Classes: Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

NZRC

Category 1: FIA Group N 4WD and S2000 plus those GpN cars whose homologation has expired up to a maximum of 4 years before the beginning of the current year.

Category 2: FIA Group N 2WD and Kiwi 2 2WD cars complying with MotorSport NZ Schedule 2WD, plus those 2WD GpN cars whose homologation has expired up to a maximum of 4 years before the beginning of the current year.

Category 3: Open Class 4WD cars complying with MotorSport NZ Schedule OC.

Category 4: Historic cars complying with MotorSport NZ Schedule RH.

(Refer NSC, Book 2, Appendix 6, section 9).

Note: All competing cars in this category will require a Certificate of Description issued by MSNZ.

CRRS and Others Classes

- Class A: - 0-1400 cc 2WD
- Class B: - 1401 - 1850 cc 2WD
- Class C: - 1851 cc and over 2WD
- Class D: - Open 4WD
- Class E: - Pre 1996 4WD

Class E - Eligibility as per 2011 Geartech Central Region Rally Series and 2011 Top Half Rally Series Rules



Competitors are permitted to enter one class only.

The Hugh Baird Memorial Rally results will be compiled from the Day Two classification of classes A, B, C, D and E

6. DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING AUDIT

Competitors must present themselves at documentation for the checking of licences and documents, issuing of competition numbers and applicable advertising material prior to presenting the car for audit scrutineering and for those cars with forced induction engines, restrictor inspection.

Cars will not be cleared to compete until all of these numbers and advertising requirements are firmly affixed in the appropriate places on the vehicle.

For those taking part in Reconnaissance, Driver Registration / Documentation, the issue of Road Books and Stage Notes will be on Thursday 18th August, at Shed 2.

11. STAGE NOTES

The use of Stage Notes will be permitted in accordance with Schedule R Article 7.1. For those competitors wishing to purchase the Stage Notes it is essential that they advise of their intention on the box provided on the entry form and submit the stage note order form direct to Neil Allport Motorsport, along with payment of \$230. (Note: this cost is included in the entry fee for NZRC competitors)

Information: The stage note system uses an automated computer program to generate a description of the special stage road using sensors fitted to a vehicle driven through each stage.

Such notes describe the route in more detail than the Road Book and can be used without reconnaissance. The purchase and use of the stage notes is a direct contract between the competitor and Neil Allport Motorsport with the organiser's involvement being limited to authorising the use and facilitating the preparation and distribution on behalf of Neil Allport Motorsport.

There is no obligation on any competitor to purchase these stage notes.

12. RECONNAISSANCE

A controlled "One Pass" reconnaissance will be available to those competitors who purchase Stage Notes. This will be held on **Friday 19th August.**

A fee will be charged for reconnaissance \$ 50-00 incl GST

Reconnaissance Regulations and Timetable will be provided with Acceptance of Entry.

13. GENERAL

13.1 Scrutineering / Documentation will be held while crews are doing Recce. It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure that their competition vehicle is presented to Documentation / Scrutineering either **in person or by their representative** with all the information required for Documentation. eg

Club Membership cards

MotorSport Licences

Vehicle Log Book

Photocopied reproduction of their Civil Drivers Licence.

- 13.3** DAMAGE: Drivers must report any damage to property or stock in writing to the next Time Control Official – (by filling in the Incident Sheet provided in the Road Book)
- 13.4** PRIZEGIVING: Will be held at Shed 2, West Quay, Napier at 1900hrs 21st August
- 13.5** NZRC, Rally Hawkes Bay and Day One competitors must go over the start ramp, the penalty for not crossing the ramp will be \$50.00. A report time to the start ramp will be advised in the Supplementary Regulations Part Two – Acceptance of Entry
- 13.6** A maximum of two service vehicle stickers will be issued per NZRC crew. Only registered service vehicles with the correct sticker will be allowed to enter the service parks.
- 13.7** Competitors must service on a ground sheet capable of holding the debris and mud that falls from the vehicle during servicing.
- 13.8** Change of No 2 Driver: in the event of illness or other exceptional circumstances, a change of No 2 Driver may be permitted at the sole discretion of the Clerk of the Course and subject to the replacement completing documentation requirements and all briefings prior to participating in the event. The change would be made at a scheduled service or regroup only with the specific permission of the Clerk of the Course. Any such change of crew will mean exclusion from the results.

Appendix 1: Stage Descriptions

Stage Descriptions

Day One of this year's event will be held in Central Hawkes Bay, using roads that have not seen a rally car for 12 years.

SS1 Salisbury – 10.58kms

A short easy stage to ease you into the event. An example of HB County Roads, Good base.

SS2 Te Uri – 10.37kms

One of the older stages from Rallies past, a drivers stage, not used for some time and somewhat shorter than usual, this stage is worth the wait. It has a rhythm of its own and a number of changes of surface that include gravel and limestone.

SS3 Old Hill Road – 7.63kms

Starting on the flat this stage climbs the hill and over to Porangahau. A good base.

SS4 / 7 Triple Bridges – 11.28kms

Starting from the Fernhill end, this stage and its water splashes are a favorite among the spectators. Has river shingle base.

SS5 Huranui – 17.91kms

Another of the old haunts of Rally HB, it has a good base. The addition of a bit of tarmac is the only change from previous years.

SS6 Clareinch – 18.19kms

The last of the old favorites, this stage is open and flowing, has a slower rhythm but will be fast.

Day Two comprises of stages in the Te Pohue and Mohaka areas.

SS8 / 11 Darky Spur 1&2 - 19.83kms

Starting from the northern end, climbs up Darky Spur around a cliff with big drops and down Waipunga to the finish. A HB county road, with a good gravel base.

SS9 / 13 Waitara 1&2 – 29.85kms

Starts on Waitara, fast, open and flowing, climbs for 13kms up to Pohokura which tightens, then down hill to the finish. A good base.

SS10 / 14 Mohaka Forest

As per previous years, this stage has always been a challenge. Starts on a main forest road then into secondary roads. Varying rhythm, good base.

SS12 Esk

The abbreviated version, starts on open flowing county road then into the forest. Some soft spots but most of it is on a good base.
