MSNZ Gold Star Hill Climb Championship Final 17th & 18th February 2018

Supplementary Regulations Part One:

1. JURISDICTION

These events are Club Sport Advanced Hill Climb's, promoted by the Hawkes Bay Car Club Inc. and comprise the sealed and gravel sections of the Final Round of the 2017/2018 Motorsport NZ Hill Climb Championship.

The events will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, Championship Articles governing the Motorsport NZ Hill Climb Championship, the current National Sporting Code of Motorsport NZ and its relevant Appendices and Schedules, particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C.

3. THE EVENT

Saturday 17th February - **Glengarry Road** sealed Hillclimb **4.6 km** in length

Sunday 18th February - **Pohokura Road** gravel Hillclimb **5 km** in length

4. ENTRY FEES (which include GST and all MSNZ levies)

5. ENTRIES

The entries open with the publication of these regulations and will be accepted up to 5.00pm on Monday 12th February 2017. Late entries may be accepted up to **8.15am** on the day of the event, but will be subject to the late entry fee. **It is the Organizers' preference to have all entries in prior to the day, to enable the names and car details to be preloaded into the results computer.**

Entries shall be made on the correct entry form and to be deemed valid must be complete in all details and accompanied by the appropriate fees. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

A maximum of two (2) competitors may share a vehicle but must inform the Secretary when submitting their entries. Two drivers = two entry forms.

Full entry fee must accompany all entries – unpaid entries will not be accepted.

A maximum of 40 entries will be accepted with preference given to registered championship entries. Non-championship entries will be accepted in order of receipt. Additional entries will be placed on the reserve list in order of receipt.

6. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS

Knowledge and Understandings: In signing the entry forms competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the Motorsport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. Particularly,

- (a) The National Sporting Code articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations, and
- (b) The Motorsport NZ Hill Climb Championship Portfolio, and
- (c) Appendix Five Schedule C.

License Requirements: All drivers shall hold an M Grade or higher Motorsport NZ issued Competition License. If the Entrant is other than the driver, an Entrants License in the name of the Entrant is required. In addition, all drivers shall hold a valid civil drivers license.

All competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.

Passengers may be carried in vehicles complying with Appendix 5, Schedule C, Part 1, of the current MSNZ Manual and must sign the passenger indemnity form at the start line.

The minimum age of any passenger is 12 years. Passengers under the age of 16 must have a completed "Clubsport Event Under Age Indemnity and Consent Form" (MSNZ form CS010) or a MSNZ competition license stamped "Authorised Minor". Form CS010 can be downloaded from the MSNZ website or will be available at the event.

7. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Two Schedule A of the Current Motorsport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations. In addition, those competitors registered for the Hill Climb Championship shall respect the provisions of Article Two of the Portfolio.

Competitors should be familiar with and adhere to the MSNZ Code of Practice – Fuel, which is available on the MSNZ website (www.motorsport.org.nz)

Classes: Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

- (1) 2WD 0 – 1800cc
- (2) 2WD 1801cc & over
- (3) 4WD pre 1996
- (4) 4WD 1996 and later

8. DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING AUDIT

Competitors must present themselves at documentation for the checking of licenses and documents (including current Club membership) **prior** to presenting their car for scrutineering.

Documentation and Scrutineering will be conducted between 8.30am and 10.00am at the event venue on Saturday 2nd April (Glengarry Rd), and between 9.45am and 10.15am at the venue on Sunday 3rd April (Pohokura Rd). For Competitors entering both days they will only need to attend documentation and Scrutineering on day one, unless there is accident damage which needs to be re-scrutineered prior to starting day two these competitors will be advised if this is required.

9. DIRECTIONS TO VENUES

SATURDAY – GLENGARRY RD: **Leave Napier** on SH2 out past the Airport in approx. 5.4km turn left onto Hill Rd (Bay View) after 1.6km turn left onto Seafield Rd, follow Seafield Rd for 9.7km then turn right onto Puketitiri Rd after 3.7km turn Right onto Glengarry Rd.

OR

Leave Hastings on Omahu Rd past the Hospital heading towards Fernhill, Follow Omahu Rd for approx. 7km, continue straight on SH 50 then at Fernhill/Taihape Rd intersection continue straight onto Swamp Rd, follow Swamp Rd for 7.8km then turn Right onto Omarunui Rd in 300m turn left onto Vicarage Rd follow this for 850m then turn left onto Dartmoor Rd (by the Puketapu Pub) follow Dartmoor Rd for 5.1km then turn Right onto Apley Rd in 6.6km turn Right onto Puketitiri Rd and then in 1.1km left onto Glengarry Rd.

SUNDAY – POHOKURA RD: Leave Napier following the sign posts to Taupo (SH5) follow SH5 for approx. 36km and turn Right at Waitara Rd follow Waitara Rd for approx. 23km to the Tee intersection with Pohokura Rd turn left and follow the road down to the river. **PLEASE NOTE: It will take over an hour to get to the venue**

RUNNING OF THE EVENT

The Clerk of Course will be located in the vicinity of the start area and will have control of the event at all times.

Roll Call and Drivers Briefing will be held in the pits each morning – Saturday 10.30am and Sunday 10.45am. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory and failure to attend may result in a penalty.

There will be a Recce convoy and then each competitor will be permitted one practice and three timed runs. The fastest time of the three official runs will be counted towards the results.

A running order will be posted on the official notice board, please try and run as close to the published order as possible. The field will be spilt to allow for dual drivers.

The use of stage or Pace Notes is not permitted throughout this event. The penalty for doing so will be exclusion.

Timing

The HBCC timing beams will be used on the start and finish line. In the event of timing equipment failure, or as a result of instruction from the Clerk of Course, a competitor will be allowed a re-run. Re-runs will not be allowed if the timing gear is displaced or damaged by the competitor.

Force Majeure: If, due to Force Majeure the required number of runs cannot be completed, the appointed Motorsport NZ Stewards, after consultation with the Clerk of Course, have the authority to approve the reduction of the minimum requirements.

10. OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARD

The Official Notice Board will be in the vicinity of the start area during the day. Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with provisions of the National Sporting Code and displayed on the Official Notice Board along with any other essential information. It is the competitors' responsibility to be acquainted with this information.

12. RESULTS

Interim results (if available) will be displayed on the notice board during the day. Competitors are NOT to enter the approach timing crew during the day unless invited to do so by the Clerk of Course or another event official. This is to prevent distractions for the timing officials.

Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the completion of the last run each day.

13. CLUB POINTS

Hawkes Bay Car Club members are eligible for points for each event towards the club championship. These will be allocated in your HBCC Classes

14. PRIZEGIVING

Saturday – There is a social evening planned, further details to follow.

The prize giving will take place at approximately 7.30pm (subject to the results being final)

Sunday – The prize giving will take place at the venue as soon as the results are deemed to be final. To allow for out of town competitors to head home from the venue following the prize giving.

15. GENERAL

Reconnaissance or Practice of the course is strictly prohibited prior to the event
